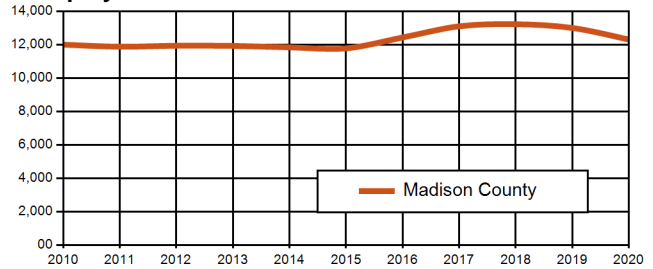

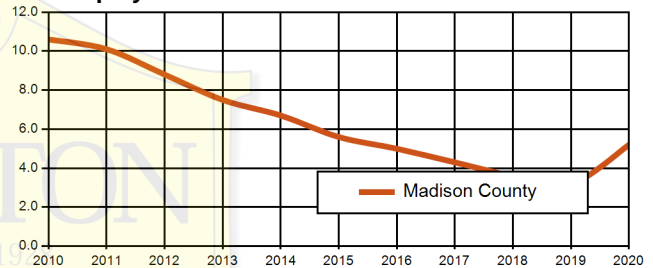

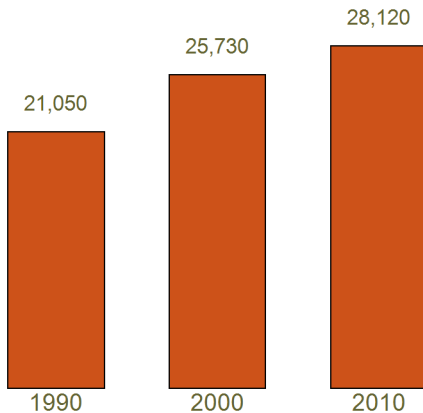
Unemployment Rate Trends

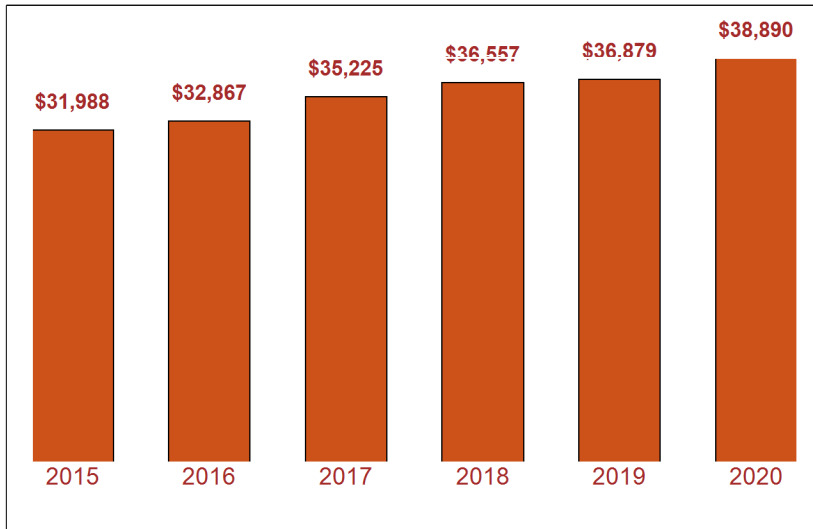

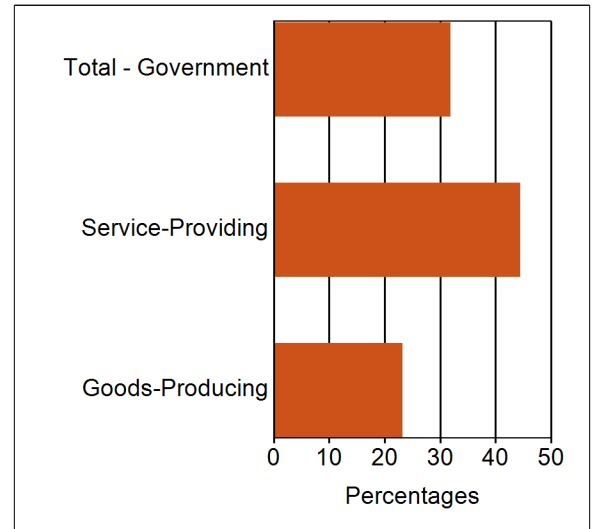
Madison Per Capita Income

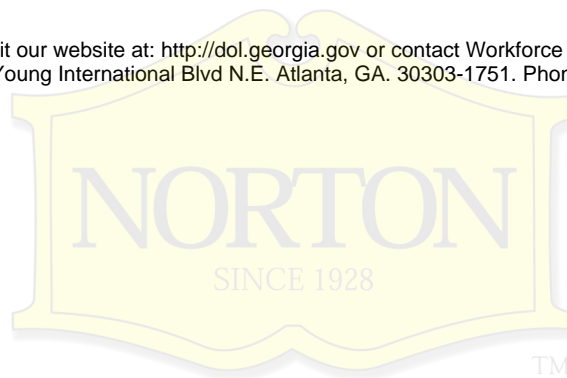
