In the identified area, the current year population is 30,154 . In 2010, the Census count in the area was 27,144 . The rate of change since 2010 was $0.94 \%$ annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 32,030 representing a change of $1.21 \%$ annually from 2021 to 2026. Currently, the population is $49.5 \%$ male and $50.5 \%$ female.

## Median Age

The median age in this area is 44.5, compared to U.S. median age of 38.5 .


Persons of Hispanic origin represent $3.6 \%$ of the population in the identified area compared to $18.9 \%$ of the U.S. population. Persons of Hispanic Origin may be of any race. The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 18.6 in the identified area, compared to 65.4 for the U.S. as a whole.

Currently, $48.0 \%$ of the 18,592 housing units in the area are owner occupied; $15.0 \%$, renter occupied; and $37.0 \%$ are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., $57.3 \%$ of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; $31.2 \%$ are renter occupied; and $11.5 \%$ are vacant. In 2010, there were 16,062 housing units in the area $-49.4 \%$ owner occupied, $16.9 \%$ renter occupied, and $33.7 \%$ vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is $6.72 \%$.
