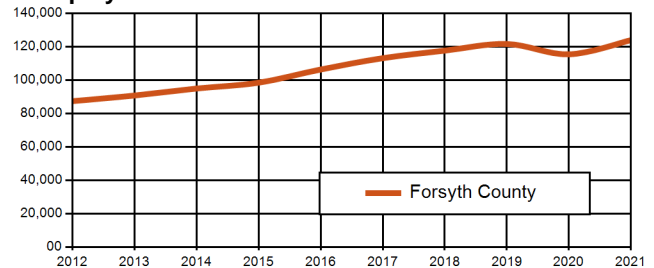

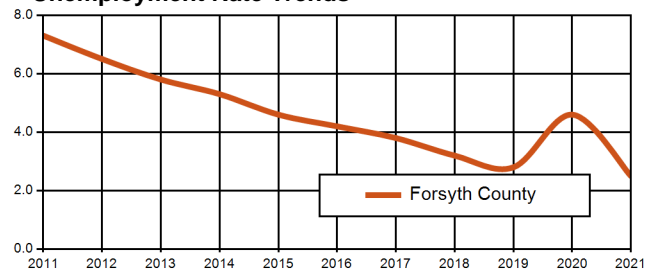

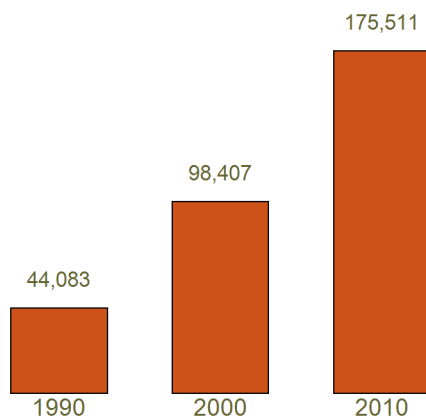
Employment Trends

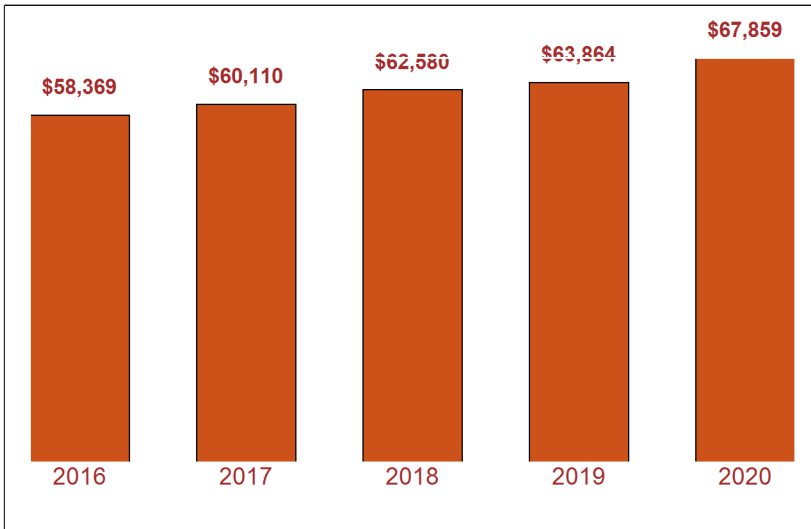

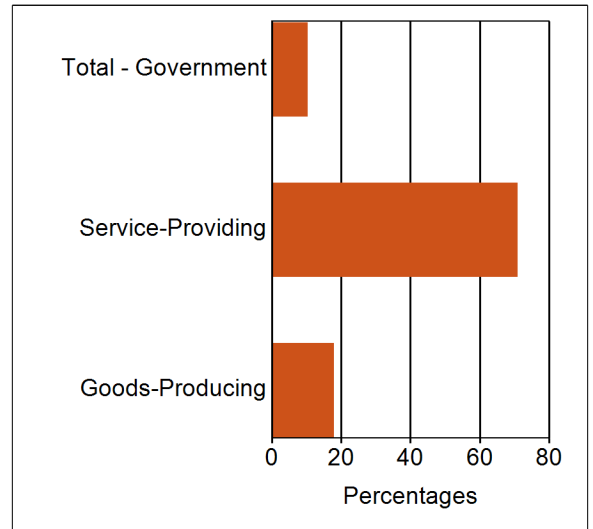
Forsyth Per Capita Income
